Setting up Web Portal access for a New User

Enable and configure the VPN Web Portal

- Click on Network and Web Publishing and then "Enable".
- Click on "Add Server..." to specify the first server hosting resources which you wish to publish.
- Enter the Full-qualified domain name for the server and click Save and then Done.
- On the Web Portal Setup page enter the Title and any Message of the Day and click Save.

The Web Portal is now created and a Network Server specified. The next step is to publish an application or shared folder.

Publish a Web Application or Web Folder

- To publish a Web Application under "Published Web Applications" click "New..."
- Select the Type of application (choose Generic if it's not listed) and specify a Friendly Name, this is the name which will appear on the Web Portal.
- Specify the application details. The details required will vary depending on the application type.
- To publish a Web Folder under "Published Web Folders" click "New..."
- Enter the folder name, URL and authentication method.

Note: to publish a shared folder it must be WebDAV-enabled and must support "anonymous" access or basic authentication.

Enabling a User for Web Portal Access

- Click on Users, the username required and then "Add New Device".
- Choose "Web Portal" and "Setup Now"
- The available applications and folders are displayed. Click "Done" to confirm or
